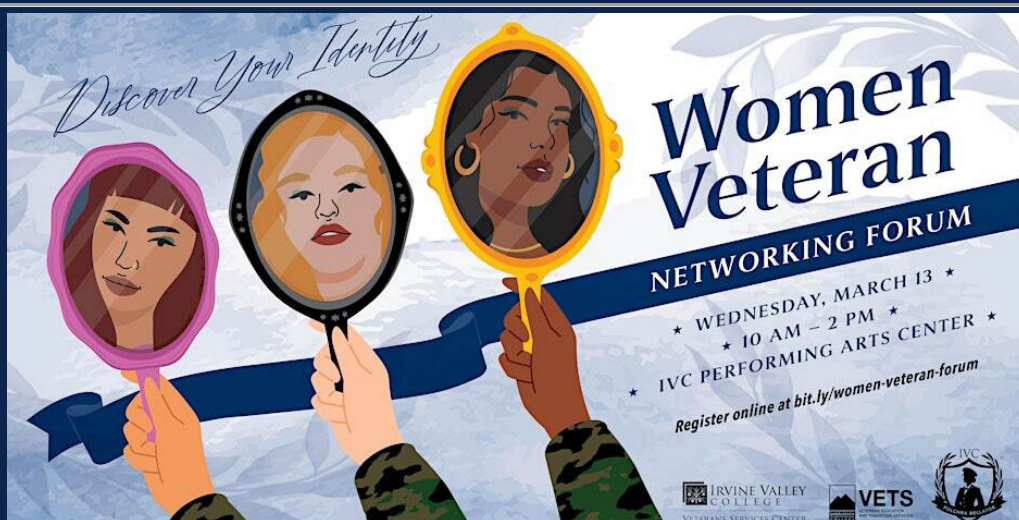


The Revolution: Southern California's Largest American Revolution Event
