VA to Extend Caregiver Support Program Eligibility for "Legacy" Veterans, Caregivers

The VA has extended eligibility for the Program of Comprehensive Assistance for Family Caregivers (PCAFC) for Veteran families and caregivers, through September 2028. This extension provides continued access to support approximately 15,000 dedicated caregivers for an additional three years.

As part of the VA's Caregiver Support Program, PCAFC provides essential clinical assistance to family caregivers of eligible Veterans with serious line-of-duty injuries, to include:

- Monthly stipends
- Education
- Respite care
- Mental health counseling
- Travel expense coverage
- Access to CHAMPVA healthcare.
